Shacharit on regular Sunday mornings begins at 8:00 AM. The times for Tefilah are subject to change.

The times for Sof Z'man Kriat Shema and Sof Z'man Tefilah follow the opinion of the GR"A.

\* The minimum time for Motza'ei Shabbat and Motza'ei Yom Tov is 50 minutes after sunset. The two more stringent times are 60 and 72 minutes after sunset.

++When there are two lines of z'manim for a single day, the second line reflects z'manim late in that day.

+ Candle lighting should be done no earlier than the time listed for the night of Yom Tov. The two more stringent times are 60 and 72 minutes after sunset.
